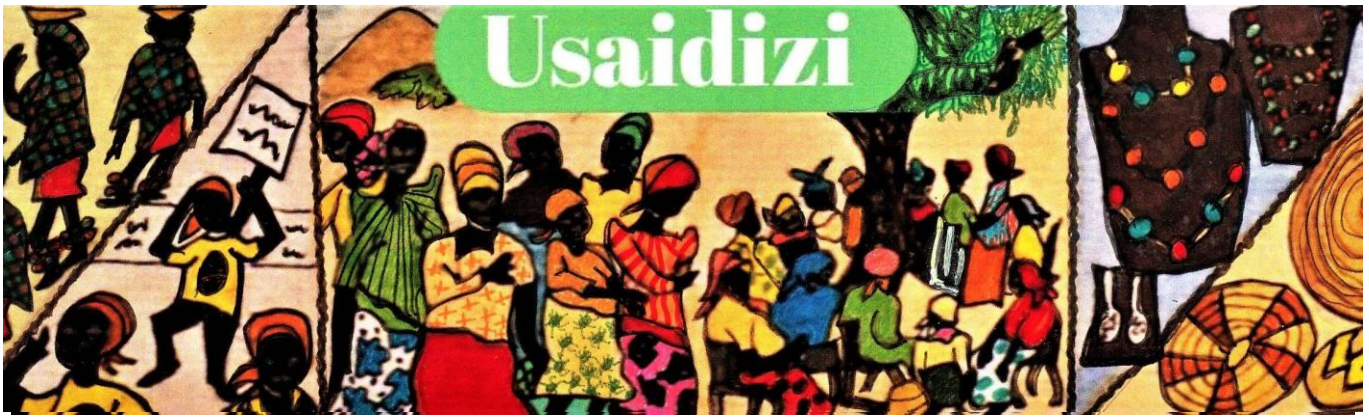

By Transit: Get off at Langara-49th station (Canada Line), cross Cambie, go to Ash and turn north.

By Car: There are 150 parking stalls underneath the Peretz Centre (see below for map to parking)
 Note: Ongoing construction may interfere with routes from 45th Avenue.

Going west on 49th, turn right into the first lane past Cambie until you reach the Centre's parking garage
 Going east on 49th, turn left on Ash, then right at the lane beside the Centre to access the parking garage
